UPDATES ON HEALTH PROTOCOL UPON ARRIVAL IN INDONESIA AS OF 7 MAY 2020

The Indonesian Ministry of Health has issued a Health Protocol upon arrival in Indonesia and on areas where Large Scale Social Distancing Policy is applicable.

The protocol is effective starting 7 May 2020.

Requirements to enter Indonesia for foreign citizens:

- 1. Wear a face mask;
- 2. Provide a valid Medical Certificate or Fit to Fly certificate in English, issued within 7 days prior to arrival;
- 3. Provide a statement of your compliance in obeying the required procedures for quarantine in Indonesia;
- 4. Obey the following medical protocol upon arrival in Indonesia:
 - a. Rapid Test and/or PCR
 - If your medical certificate confirms a negative COVID-19 PCR result, you will skip this test.
 - If your medical certificate does not confirm a negative COVID-19 PCR result, you must take this test.
 - b. Interview
 - c. Temperature check and other relevant tests
 - d. Oxygen Saturation Test

Follow up actions based on the test result:

- 1. Individuals with **negative** COVID-19 result, shows no symptom, and without comorbidity will:
 - Receive a health clearance, a Health Alert Card, and a travel permit (Surat Jalan).
 - Submit the health clearance to the respective embassies and to be monitored by a local Health Agency.
 - Self-quarantine at for 14 days.
- 2. Individuals with **reactive** rapid test result **and comorbidity** will be referred to and isolated at a designated hospital.
- 3. Individuals with reactive rapid test, without comorbidity, will be deported.
